APPLE BANANA SALAD WITH PEANUTS (4 SERVINGS)



DCC Visitors found this fresh, flavorful change of pace USDA recipe, great for a quick, easy meal on a busy day. Serve with WG (whole-grain) bread & milk for a super lunch! *NOTE: Of course, don't serve to those with peanut allergies or to infants.*

Ingredients:

5 C lettuce mix
2 ripe bananas
2 1/2 medium apples, sliced
3/4 C unsalted dry roasted peanuts

For Dressing:

1/3 C plain low-fat yogurt
2 T low-fat mayo
1 T honey
2 t paprika

Whisk together dressing ingredients. Slice bananas. In large salad bowl, toss mixed greens, banana & apple slices, peanuts & dressing. Crunchy! Healthy! Fun!
